## ASH WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 25TH

**ASH WEDNESDAY:** Ashes will be distributed during Masses, which will be celebrated at 9:00 AM and 7:00 PM, and also during a Prayer service, which will be held at 4:00 PM.

**ABSTINENCE:** Catholics over 14 years are bound to the obligation of abstinence. Abstinence is observed on Ash Wednesday and Fridays of Lent. On days of abstinence meat may not be used at all.

**FAST:** Catholics over 18 and up to the beginning of their sixtieth year are bound to the obligation of fasting. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. On these days only one full meal is allowed. Regarding other weekdays we strongly recommend participation in daily Mass and voluntary observance of fasting.

### RCIA--The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:

Are you or is someone you know interested in becoming a Catholic or completing Sacramental Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation) in the Church? The RCIA is a communal faith experience of adult instruction and dialogue.
