Dear Friends:

Faith and good works, so evident in this community, are essential elements for the wellbeing of any parish. Financial stability, too, is a necessary part of parish life. Saint Rose of Lima Parish is dependent upon the financial generosity of this community in carrying out our mission and ministries. Our Grand Annual appeal began last weekend. The Grand Annual collection is part of our yearly parish budget and its proceeds go directly to meeting our ordinary weekly expenses. Our expenses continue to rise for property maintenance, energy/utilities, insurance, religious education, music and liturgy, salaries and benefits, etc. Presently, we are also engaged in enhancing our worship space and other capital improvements. I ask your help in supporting Saint Rose of Lima’s mission and ministries by contributing to our parish’s Grand Annual collection in the days and weeks ahead.

Our Parish Finance Council, in evaluating our budgetary needs, has underscored the importance of the Grand Annual collection for the financial wellbeing of the parish. Last year, through your generosity, our appeal raised approximately \$82,000. Mindful that these are difficult financial times for some, we have raised our goal only modestly to \$85,000 this year. In order to meet this goal, we need the support of all of our parishioners. I ask that parishioners consider a \$400 to \$500 contribution to realize this goal. Clearly, each one of us knows best what we are able to contribute as a sacrificial offering; some may not be able to contribute financially at all, while others may be capable of an even more significant monetary offering.

Grand Annual contributions may be placed in the regular collection at any Sunday Mass, mailed or dropped off at the Rectory Office. Thank you for your kind support of our Parish.
