

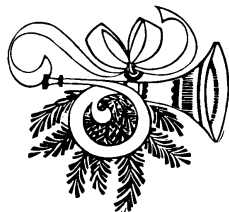
## Religious Education
