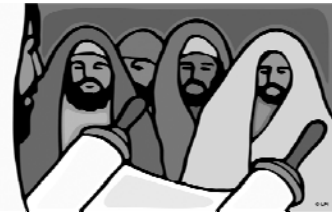

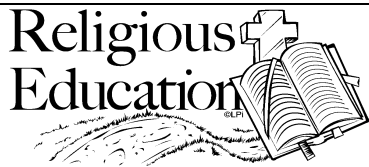
Make A Joyful Noise Unto The Lord, all ye Lands
